Reading Kingdom is designed to be done on a computer with an Internet connection.

However, you can also use Reading Kingdom on iPads with the help of apps that make Flash content available on the iPad.



Photon

One of the best performing apps we have found is called Photon Browser. It currently costs US\$4.99 (though their website lists the regular price as US\$9.99. You can find the Photon Browser here:

iSwifter

Another app is called iSwifter. It is free to try and \$5 to purchase.

When you run Reading Kingdom on an iPad don't forget to set Reading Kingdom to use the on-screen keyboard.

To do this, when you log in and you go to the reader page, at the top of the page just below the "Click to continue" button is the option.



Select the option to "Use an onscreen keyboard for the program."
