

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Steps to Stories

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Level B - Story 14

Step a. What to do: Point to the picture. Say, "This story is called Getting Warm." Turn the page.



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What to do: Offer Module I or II depending on results of Skills Assessment. Say, "Listen. Say this." Then read each sentence aloud. Follow guidelines in Sample Session (Section V). When all sentences are completed, turn the page.
