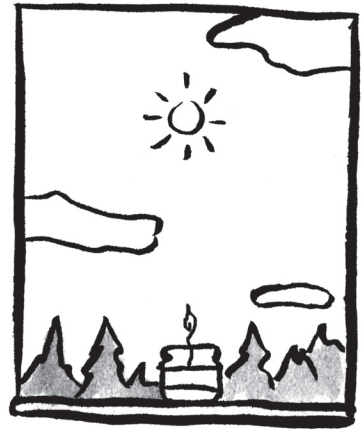


MAKE YOUR OWN WATCH IT JIGGLE PLANT SEEDLING

Since plants start to grow beneath the soil, it's hard to watch seeds sprouting without digging them up. By using gelatin instead of soil you can actually see the plants begin to develop!



1 Mix the gelatin according to the package directions. You only need one packet, and you'll have some left over.

2 Pour the gelatin into the baby food jar. You

don't need to fill it all the way—about an inch is fine. To feed your plant, add two drops of liquid house plant fertilizer.

Supplies

- ❁ plain gelatin
- ❁ very clean baby food jar
- ❁ liquid house plant fertilizer
- ❁ seeds—bean seeds grow quickly, but you can use any seed you have available

3 Let the gelatin cool and firm up. When it's ready, drop a seed or two on top of the gelatin.

4 Place the jar in a sunny place and check it every day to watch the plant grow. You can draw pictures every couple of days to record the progress.
