What To Do:

1. Say, "Some words here say luck or lucky & some do not." 2. Point to → in the 1st row. Say, "Cross out any word that does NOT say luck or lucky." 3. Point to any word luck or lucky & say, "What word is this?" Make sure child starts at the left & works to the right across the row.

Immediately correct any error. Repeat for each row.
